Rachel writes: 'The world in which we live feels increasingly fragile and can leave us anxious, tired and over-exposed. Across five sessions, I will explore how it is possible to more richly and hopefully inhabit the 'broken middle': the facts and promise to be found in a messy, complex world. By treating with and embracing the broken middles of body, self, faith and world, it is possible to find joy and goodness in fragility'.



The Rev'd Canon Dr Rachel Mann is a priest, writer, theologian and broadcaster. She has written fifteen books, including the acclaimed 'Fierce Imaginings' and 'Dazzling Darkness', as well as a poetry collection and novel. She regularly contributes to Thought For The Day, Pause For Thought and a range of radio programmes. She is a member of the Church of England's Faith and Order Commission and a Visiting Fellow at Manchester Met University.
